Address the Growing Iranian Threat

SECTION 1. The U.S Government will enact and enforce sanctions on Iran, declare the Strait of Hormuz a Free Trade Zone, and is authorized to use cyber security assets to weaken Iranian interests.

SECTION 2. Sanctions will include both economic and political deterrents that weaken Iran's ability to conduct business, run its government, and control its citizens. The Free Trade Zone will stretch from the Persian Gulf to the Indian Ocean and declare that all merchant vessels are allowed to freely pass through the zone uninterrupted by any power. The U.S Government will also be allowed to use cyber warfare to destroy Iranian domestic military capabilities.

SECTION 3. Sanctions will be carried out by the Departments of the Treasury, State, Commerce, and Defense. The Free Trade Zone will be enacted and enforced by the U.S Navy and the Department of State. Cyber operations will be authorized to the CIA and Department of Defense Assets.

A. The President will be authorized to ask congress for additional assets at his discretion to mandate this act.

SECTION 4. This Bill is enacted on the Twentieth of April in the Year 2012

SECTION 5. All previous articles of legislation remain law.
